This letter is in regards to the compliance assistance visit that Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) staff performed on May 31, 2013. DEQ Electronic Waste Program Coordinator, Melissa Adler-McKibben, was present for the visit.

The Oklahoma Computer Equipment Recovery Act (the Act) became effective on January 1st, 2009. The purpose of the law is to establish a convenient and environmentally sound recovery program for the collection, recycling and reuse of covered devices that have reached the end of their useful lives. DEQ staff does not regulate electronics recyclers under the Act; however compliance assistance visits can be performed at the request of the recycler, the customer, or the public.

This letter is to inform you that during the visit no violations were cited and facility operations appeared to be run in a safe, and effective, manner. In addition, it was noted CDR Global Inc. had taken commendable measures to become nationally certified. Furthermore, CDR Global Inc. implemented additional procedures to run the facility in an efficient, and environmental, way through lean business practices.
